Application for Permit for Activities on a Wetland or Controlled Area

Instructions: Please use typewriter or print clearly in ink. Submit seven (7) copies of this application and seven (7) copies of all specified supporting plans and documentation. Include with application a list of all adjacent property owners and property owners 100 feet upstream and 500 feet downstream of the property in question. If applicant is not the property owner, written consent of the owner must accompany this application. This application must be submitted to the Water Control Commission prior to the issuance of any building other permits.

8. Plans and Specifications: Detail plans and specifications for the proposed wetland activity, drawn to a scale of not smaller than 1" = 50', shall show the following:
 - a. Location of disturbed area. The location of the area proposed to be disturbed and its relation to property lines, buildings, roads, controlled areas and watercourses within 250 feet.
 - b. Quantity of Material. Estimated quantities of material to be deposited or removed.
 - c. Location of wells/septics. The location of any well and depth thereof, and of any septic or other waste disposal system within 250 feet of the proposed project.
 - d. Drainage System details. The details of any proposed drainage system, both for the construction of the system and the final development and maintenance of the system.

- e. Construction detail/deposition of spoil. Where creation, modification, or enlargement of a pond or lake is proposed, details of the construction of any dams, embankments, outlets, or other water-control devices and of deposition of the spoil material.
 - f. List of affected functions. A list of all beneficial functions of the wetland, waterbody, or watercourse which will be affected by the proposed activities.
 - g. Details of protection procedure. A diagram showing what erosion controls will be installed, and a schedule for their installation and maintenance.
9. Applicant may be required to include a topographical map including existing and adjusted contours at 2-foot intervals in the area of the proposed project, and to a distance of 50 feet beyond said project.
 10. Applications affecting the water retention capacity, water flow, or other drainage characteristics of any waterbody, watercourse, rainfall drainage system, or wetland shall include a statement including numerical calculations of the impact of the project on upstream and downstream areas. Specific attention shall be given to 100-year storm levels.
 11. Applicant shall provide any other information the Commission feels is necessary to demonstrate that the proposed project (activity) is not adverse to the general health, safety, economic, and general welfare of the residents of the village.
 12. Plans and specifications submitted with this application shall be prepared and certified by an engineer, architect or landscape architect licensed by the State of New York. The Commission may, upon request by an Applicant, waive this requirement in its discretion.
 13. Approvals required from any other agency or governmental unit must be obtained prior to final approval by the Water Control Commission.
 14. Term of permit is subject to terms as set forth in Section 5.17 of Local Law November 4, 1988, "protection of Wetlands, Waterbodies, and Watercourses."
 15. Fee: See Village Fee Schedule.
